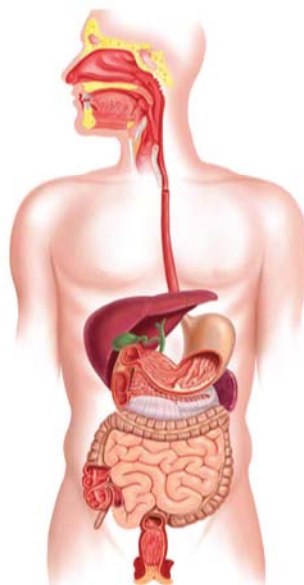

  - Comprehensive hepatitis activity score

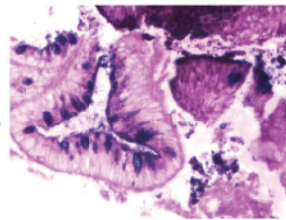

- A. DISTAL ESOPHAGUS, MUCOSA (BIOPSY):**
- BARRETT'S ESOPHAGUS, INCOMPLETE TYPE, NEGATIVE FOR DYSPLASIA
  - MODERATE CHRONIC ACTIVE CARDITIS
  - MILD REFLUX ESOPHAGITIS OF SQUAMOUS MUCOSA
  - NO GRANULOMATA/ORGANISMS IDENTIFIED



Blue Staining Intestinal Metaplasia (Alcian Blue Stain)

**Special Stains:**  
For diagnostic purposes additional studies were ordered by the attending pathologist  
Stains performed at SEPA  
Controls react appropriately  
Representative tissue identified in all sections examined  
A. PAS: Negative for fungal organisms  
A. Alcian Blue: Focally positive for intestinalization (goblet cells)

**Immunohistochemical Stains:**

A. Specimen designated "distal esophagus".  
Specimen consists of two fragments of tan tissue each measuring 0.1 cm in diameter.  
Section Code A-specimens submitted in toto.
